2. Measures to reduce the risk of bridge strikes at Cannondown Arch	Cllr Coker	Still being investigated. Researching equipment being used by neighbouring Councils.
3. Harris-Woodbridge Conservation Area enhancement	Cllr Nye	Management Plan under consideration by FPOS Committee.
4. Community engagement for Britain in Bloom 2016	Cllr Brar	FPOS reviewing plans for 2016 in November.
5. Keep Cookham Tidy	Cllrs Doyle and Tull	Next event planned for January 2016.
6. Tree survey	Cllr Hewer	Completed in October. 85 significant trees identified and remedial work recommended.
7. Review of the Alfred Major Recreation Ground	Cllr Nye	FPOS Committee considering initial steps to enable review to be implemented over the next 12-18 months.
8. Tourism Action Plan	Cllr Kellaway	New signage planned. High Street website will spread information.
9. Telephone Boxes	Cllr Bune	Library now operational in Bigfrith Lane tel box. No suggested use at present for Dean Lane box due to its location.
10. Bird and bat boxes	Cllr L Tull	Currently liaising with NT and wildlife expert for guidance.
11. Congestion and Parking problems on Station Hill	Cllr Barnes	Monitoring of the site will continue to assess impact of recent changes.
12. Liaise with Cookham Society to review VDS recommendations.	Cllr Hewer	Further discussions planned with new Cookham Soc Chairman.
13. Review Speeding on Lower Road	Cllr Nye	Site visits and speed surveys carried out. Next steps being considered.
